Information clause of BNP Paribas Bank Polska S.A. on the use of CCTV monitoring

Pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data ("GDPR") and repealing Directive 95/46/EC, the controller of your personal data is BNP Paribas Bank Polska S.A. ("Bank") having its registered office in Warsaw (01-211), ul. Kasprzaka 2.

The Bank shall process personal data from CCTV monitoring in order to pursue the legitimate interests of the Bank (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR), which the Bank specifically considers to be the need to ensure the security of persons and property within the Bank's facilities, the Bank's internal administration and information security (including respect for bank secrecy), the possibility of pursuing or defending claims, as well as the application of internal processes for the supervision of lawfulness and counteracting fraud.

You have the right to object to the processing of data collected using CCTV monitoring.

In connection with the processing of data for the purposes indicated above, your data from CCTV monitoring records may be transferred to entities processing personal data at the request of the controller, including entities responsible for the supervision of the operation of CCTV monitoring and system maintenance, and such entities process data under an agreement with the controller and only in accordance with the instructions of the controller. Your personal data will be stored for the period necessary to fulfil the purposes for which they were collected, but no longer than 3 months, and in the event of an objection – until the objection is filed. Where the data processing is based on legal regulations, the data shall be retained for the period defined in the specific regulations. Also, in justified cases (e.g., for evidentiary purposes), video monitoring recordings may be stored for a longer period for the purpose of internal investigations or other proceedings, e.g., court proceedings.

In connection with the processing of your personal data by the Bank, you have the right to access your data (Article 15 of the GDPR), to rectify it (Article 16 of the GDPR), to remove the data (Article 17 of the GDPR), to restrict the processing of the data (Article 18 of the GDPR) and the right to lodge an objection to data processing (Article 21 of the GDPR).

You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority competent for the personal data protection.

Data collected by video surveillance shall not be processed by automated means.
